

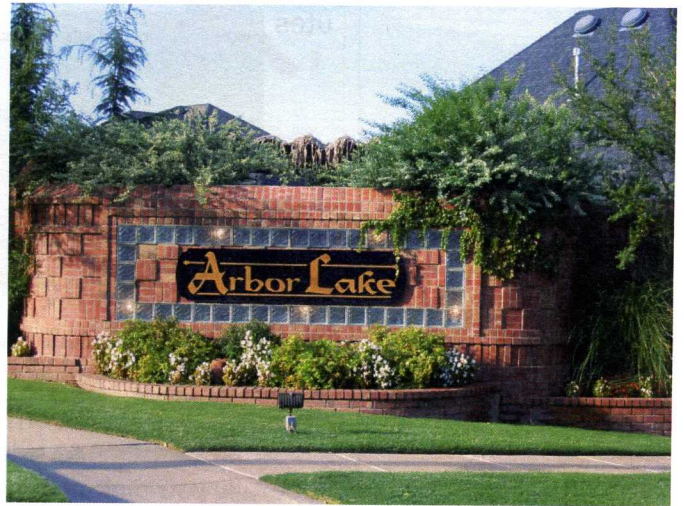

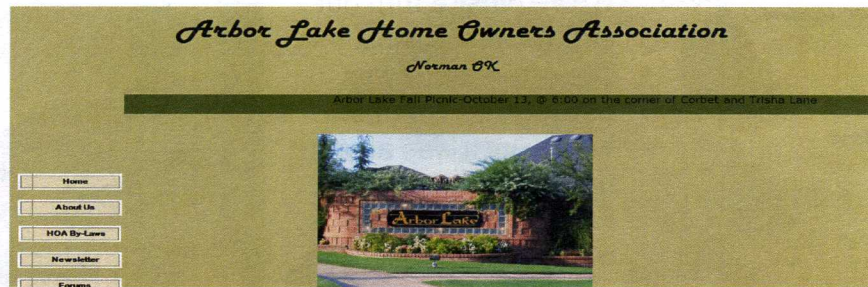
WEBSITE UPDATE

HOW TO USE A FORUM

Hopefully you picked up a copy of the hand out on the basics of "How to use a Forum." Here are some more tips.

Q: How do I add an image to my post?

A: When posting a reply or starting a new

topic, at the bottom of box you will see "Add image to post". Click on it. Another box will open. If your click on the **browse** button it will bring up files on your computer. In the next box, you can add a description of the picture. Then click **upload**. Your picture is now ready to be

added to your post. You can hit the **pre-view** button before you submit to make sure it turned out the way you wanted. Just remember pictures can not exceed 2mb. You can use a pixel re-sizer to resize your pictures. My favorite is PIXresizer. It is free. (Continued pg3)

This software is great for making your photos smaller for emailing as well.

Q: How do I create a poll?

A: At the bottom of your new post there is an option to **add a poll**. Click it and you will see a box to add your **selection options**. I created one in the test section called "Have you ever used a forum before". Once you create it and submit your response you can see the results. You can only submit to

the poll once.

The results will display the percentage of answers which were selected and how many people have responded to the poll.
