HOW TO USE A FORUM (Q & A)

Q. What are the red stars under the users name?

A. The red stars are user rankings. The rankings are based on the number of posts that each user has.

Q. What is a "sticky"?

A. Sticky's are an-

nouncements or user information that the administrator want to keep at the top of the list.

Q. When can I see the results of a poll?

A. After you respond to the poll with your selection, you will see the results, both in percent-
